Re: Requested answers to information requested in 11/7/2017 letter concerning your request for Redress

Dear Mr. McDonald and Mr. Alyn:

Upon reviewing the information provided by Mr. Alyn in his letter of January 10, the NBYA Appeals Committee finds that he has not provided the following information requested in my letter of 11/7/17. (See that letter.)


- +A list of competitors and contact information (as this matter relates to a request for redress, all competitors have a right to be included in this correspondence as the decision will affect their scores for the race and series.)
- +Time and positions of competitors when the RC signaled "S".
- +Order in which competitors rounded mark #12.
- +A list of competitors who had rounded mark #12 when the RC signaled "S"

The Appeals Committee directs that there be a new hearing with all competitors notified of the time and place of the hearing and of their opportunity to attend. The new hearing should have at least one certified judge on the panel. (Mr. Alyn is no longer a US Sailing certified judge).

It would appear from Mr. Alyn's letter that there was no reopening of the hearing with a new panel including at least one US Sailing certified judge as suggested by my November 7 letter.

It is possible that as a result of the new hearing, additional facts or a different conclusion and decision may be reached, which may also include abandoning the race. Please ask the organizing authority to arrange for the new hearing with all competitors having the opportunity to be represented as soon as possible.
